Long-term Reservation Terms & Conditions

Long term camp reservations are only available to Crockango Club members.

This includes 6 pax camping for one calendar year free of charge, on your specific camp site.

Payment for a new reservation application consists of a once-off camp section amount plus the levy options amount which is payable yearly until long term reservation on campsite is cancelled.

Campsites are only available for long term reservation from January up to end February the next year. If yearly levy is not renewed before end February, long term reservation is cancelled.

A current occupant on a campsite from the year before will have first option to renew his/her campsite for the next calendar year.

You may lose priority for renewal of long-term reservation or expulsion from your campsite should misconduct occur from you or any additional campers.

You may not re-lease out your campsite or ask any monies from people to camp on your campsite.

You are allowed to build a braai, kitchen unit (shower unit can be added to kitchen unit), install a water connection to your campsite and build a concrete floor with overhead roof structure for tents (this is on your own cost and stays the property of Crockango Angling Club) which must comply with Crockango Angling Club regulations as pre-determined plans. All showers and geysers will stay the responsibility of the owner.

Application to be handed in to the committee. All alterations must be approved by the committee. The costing of braai, kitchen unit and water connection can be confirmed with the committee and will be refunded to the owner as soon as the club has the finances to do so.

You may plant indigenous trees on your campsite. (Please consult committee before doing so). No trees can be removed to build any structure without permission from the committee. Camp owners also have an extra option to have a lawn on their campsites planted by die Crockango Club (please consult current Committee for planting off lawn)

After fixtures have been build and paid back to member the levy of you camp will be adjusted on the next year's renewal application. Members have a choice to have levies deducted annually from credit amount of fixtures built.

Shower units are not refunded and stay responsibility of member for maintenance. Should member decide to not renew their membership and not continue to renew campsite long term lease. The shower values will be calculated over a 10-year depreciation period and the years left of the 10 years will be paid out to member. After 10 Years have lapsed it's considered as fully paid back to member.

Front row campsite reservations may build a front erosion wall to level out ground at Crockango club specifications.

If you not occupying your campsite for any specific weekend or day, Crockango may rent out the camp site. These long-term reservations are for Crockango camp ground development purposes and no individual will financially benefit by this exercise. Crockango Club Committee reserves the right to amend and apply new rules and regulations to Camp Crockango.
